# **Policy Dialogues**

#### DPG-CSIS Dialogue and Report Launch, New Delhi, August 19, 2019



DPG hosted a policy dialogue with Dr. John J. Hamre, President and CEO, CSIS, Washington D.C. on August 19, 2019. Dr. Hamre was accompanied by Mr. Richard M. Rossow, India-Chair at CSIS. They were joined by fifteen Indian participants, drawn from DPG, strategists from think tanks and senior government officials from MoD/IDS and MEA. The dialogue saw a wide ranging exchange of views on US foreign policy trends and the current climate of US-India bilateral relations. A CSIS/DPG White Paper on US-India Maritime Security Cooperation was launched at the event.

# DPG Dialogue with Foundation for Defense of Democracies, Washington D.C., New Delhi, August 29, 2019

DPG hosted a delegation from the Center on Military and Political Power (CMPP) of the Foundation for Defense of Democracies, Washington DC on August 29, 2019. The CMPP team was headed by Mr. Bradley Bowman, Senior Director. The agenda for discussions, which were held under the Chatham House Rule, focused on global geopolitical developments, particularly in the Indo-Pacific, and how to take India-US relations forward.

### Roundtables

DPG-DIA Workshop for Defence Attachés (Designate), New Delhi, July 9, 2019



In collaboration with the Defence Intelligence Agency, the Delhi Policy Group organised a one day Workshop for Indian Defence Attachés (Designate) on July 9, 2019. The Opening Session of the Workshop was attended by Lt. Gen. A.S. Bedi, UYSM, YSM, VSM, Director General, Defence Intelligence Agency and Air Marshal Rajeev Sachdeva, AVSM, Deputy Chief of Integrated Defence Staff (Policy Planning & Force Development). Attendees included 14 Defence Attachés (Designate), who are preparing for their assignments abroad to various Indian diplomatic missions in Asia and Europe. Sessions at the Workshop covered global geopolitical trends, India's major power relations, India and the Indo-Pacific, India's challenges of capability development and India as an attractive economic destination. The DPG Senior Faculty held an interactive dialogue with H.E. Mr. Pham Sanh Chau, Ambassador of Vietnam on August 6, 2019. Discussions at the roundtable covered strategic and security issues of the Indo-Pacific and India's bilateral relations with Vietnam, against the backdrop of the recently concluded ASEAN Post-Ministerial Conference (PMC) meetings.





In collaboration with the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia, the Delhi Policy Group organized a one-day Roundtable Discussion on India-Indonesia relations to commemorate the 70th anniversary of the establishment of full diplomatic ties. The keynote address at the roundtable was delivered by H.E. Ms. Vijay Thakur Singh, Secretary (East) in the Ministry of External Affairs. Participants included senior officials and prominent strategists from both countries. The roundtable saw in-depth discussion of India-Indonesia relations, both bilateral and in the wider context of the Indo-Pacific, ranging from defence and security to trade and economy. Outcomes and recommendations will be shared with the respective governments.
