Delhi Policy Group - US National War College Discussion

April 09, 2024

The Delhi Policy Group held an interactive discussion with the faculty and student officers of the US National War College (NWC) on April 9, 2024. This was the fourth iteration of an annual DPG-NWC dialogue. The 12-member team of US NWC officers was led by Professor Gregory Macris. The senior faculty DPG shared perspectives on global order and regional security challenges, India's role stabilising in continental Asia and the Indo-Pacific maritime, and prospects for enhanced India-US defence and security partnership. This was followed by an extended Q&A interaction with the student officers of the US NWC.





Roundtable Discussion On India's Maritime Security Coordination Vision

April 12, 2024

The Delhi Policy Group (DPG) organised a roundtable discussion on "India's Maritime Security Coordination Vision" on April 12, 2024. Vice Admiral G Ashok Kumar, National Maritime Security Coordinator (NMSC) was the keynote speaker.

NMSC's The role and responsibilities in synergising the working of diverse agencies responsible for coastal and offshore security and addressing multiple challenges in the maritime domain was discussed at length.

The roundtable brought together senior strategic experts and contributed to the understanding of challenges and complexities of harnessing India's maritime capabilities.

<u>Fifth Annual Delhi Policy</u> <u>Group–Defence Intelligence</u> <u>Agency Workshop for Defence</u> <u>Attachés (Designate)</u>

April 22, 2024

The Delhi Policy Group (DPG) organised a one-day training workshop for Indian Defence Attachés (Designate) in collaboration with the Defence Intelligence Agency on April 22, 2024. This was the fifth iteration of





the annual DPG-DIA training workshop and was attended by 18 Defence Attachés (Designate) and two DIA officers.

The DPG Senior Faculty and guest speakers made presentations to the Defence Attachés (Designate) on the current state of the global order, great power rivalry, India's strategic posture, the impact of technology on warfare, the evolving nuclear landscape, security challenges in India's continental neighbourhood and maritime domain, relations with key neighbours and major powers, and efforts to enhance economic security and resilience.

DPG-CSIS Workshop on Future Horizons of India-US Defence Cooperation

June 26, 2024

Against the backdrop of continuing progress in the India-US strategic partnership, the DPG senior faculty participated in a DPG-CSIS workshop on the "Future Horizons of India-US Cooperation" Defence at the Center for Strategic and International Studies in Washington D.C. on June 26, workshop 2024. The was organised jointly by DPG and the India Chair at CSIS as part of their annual interaction on bilateral relations. Senior US government officials. members of the Congressional staff from the SFRC and the HFAC, subject matter experts from US think tanks, and





representatives from the US defence industry participated in the closed door event. Views were exchanged on advancing operational cooperation, defence technology and manufacturing cooperation, and cooperation in new domains, including Cyber and Space.

DPG-Hudson Institute Dialogue

June 27, 2024

The DPG senior faculty held an interactive dialogue with counterparts at the Hudson Institute in Washington D.C. on June 27, 2024.

Participants included representatives branches from of the US government and academia. Views were exchanged on a wide variety of major regional and global issues, the progress of the India-US strategic partnership, and security challenges in the Indo-Pacific. At the conclusion of the discussion, the DPG delegation made presentations on India's highly successful general election which has showcased the strengthening of India's vibrant democracy, prospects for future India-US military operational cooperation, and the outlook for India-US cooperation in defence technology and manufacturing. The closed door annual dialogue was organised in conjunction with the Initiative for India and South Asia at the Hudson Institute.
